How to reach Arles from Marseille?

Whether you arrive in Marseille by train at St Charles Station or at the Marseille Provence airport, the best solution to reach Arles is to take a TER (Local Train: "Train Express Régional") towards Arles Station (Gare SNCF).

- From Marseille St Charles station, you can find it directly inside the station. The final destination should be Avignon, Valence, Carpentras or Nîmes, Montpellier.
- From Marseille Provence Airport, you should first reach the "Vitrolles Aéroport Marseille Provence" (VAMP), also called "Vitrolles Gare SNCF", which is on the same train line going from Marseille St Charles station to Arles. Going out from the hall of the airport, you should reach the "Gare Routière" and take the shuttle Bus N°13. The travel takes 7 mn with a 12 to 15 mn frequency. The cost is 1 €. The timetables and map are given hereafter.








You must ensure that the train you take in Marseille or VAMP station will stop in Arles. It is the case for all the train whose final destination is Avignon-Centre. As you can see on the map of the TER network for the South area of France, given below, the terminus can also be Orange, Valence, Carpentras or Nîmes, Montpellier.




- From Marseille St Charles, the TER reaches Arles (4th stop after VAMP, Miramas and Saint-Martin-de-Crau on most trains) in 1h10mn. There is a train roughly every hour, the cost is around 20 €.
- From "VAMP station", the TER reaches Arles (3rd stop after Miramas and Saint-Martin-de-Crau on most trains) in 45 to 50 mn. There is a train roughly every hour, the cost is around 15 €. The platform is "Voie 2" indicated as "Miramas, Avignon, Montpellier" (opposite to Voie 1 towards Marseille).



Map of Arles public transport network




Map of Arles bus line "1" : Gare SNCF <> Barriol


